

EEPC BIG BEAR TRIP 2018 GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

- Pack all essential medications and treatments needed during the trip.
- DO NOT leave the resort without permission of an adult chaperone.
- MUST follow curfew rules. All students must be back at the resort by **10:00 P.M.**
- Lock cabin doors after curfew every night.
- BE courteous and respectful to the staff at the resort, EEP adult chaperones, and fellow EEPsters.
- Be aware that behavior MUST be appropriate, activities are safe, and night time is peaceful.
- NO disruptive behavior or conduct that will endanger the life, safety, health, or well-being of others.
- NO alcohol or recreational substances permitted.
- No co-ed or couples bed-sharing.
- Respect the facilities. DO NOT damage or destroy property, and always clean up after yourself
